## **CCRG UPDATE**

Planning for the implementation of College and Career Ready Graduates (CCRG) legislation is ongoing and guided by the system office. Currently, there are seven schools working with high school partners on a variety of approaches to provide high school seniors remediation that will provide them the opportunity to be college ready upon graduation. Those schools are Pitt, Davidson, AB Tech, Alamance, CPCC, Randolph, and Brunswick.

There are three regional information sessions between March 15 and April 3. All colleges were invited, along with all school districts in the state. Hopefully, your college or even you were/are able to attend. These sessions did/will include representatives from current model college/high school partnerships who will share information about how to begin a partnership, what costs are involved, what decisions need to be made, and how to implement the final CCRG solution.

In the Fall of 2017, CCRG will enter Phase II of the project. Colleges interested in participating will have the opportunity to adopt a model to implement with at least one high school partner. This will allow Phase II colleges to be a step ahead before full implementation of the legislation across the state in Fall 2018.
